

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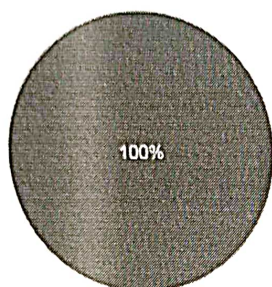
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Environment Day Analysis Academic Year 2023-24

19 responses

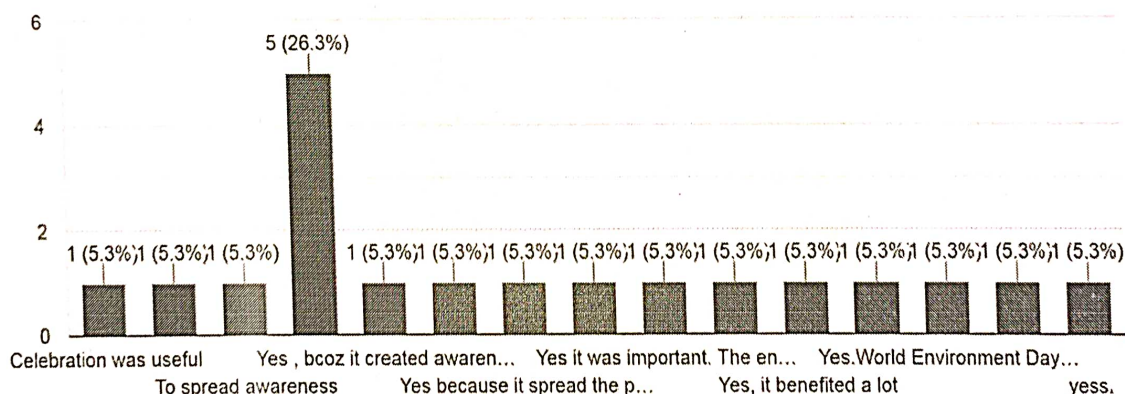


● Yes

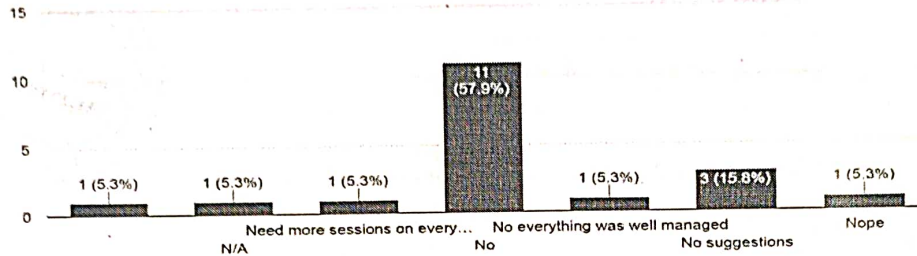


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Any suggestion?
