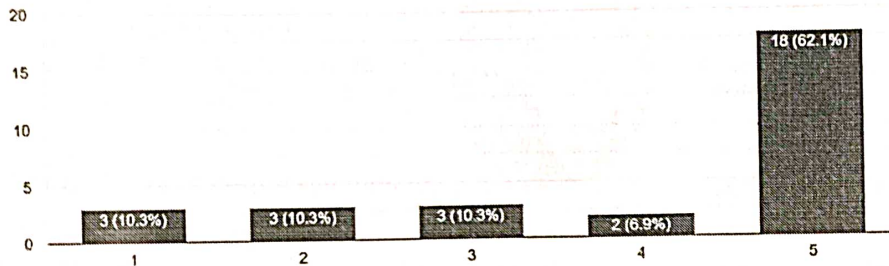
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Freshers Day Analysis Academic Year 2023-24

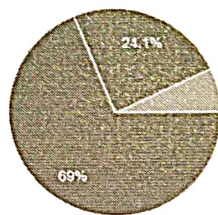


How would you rate the overall experience of the fresher party?

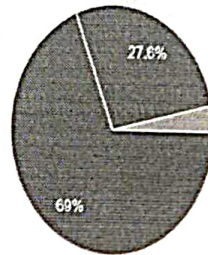
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sentiment points towards a well-organized and successful fresher event that garnered positive responses from the majority of attendees.

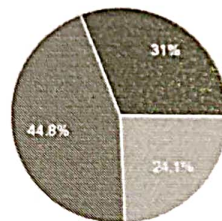


- Highly engaging and enjoyable

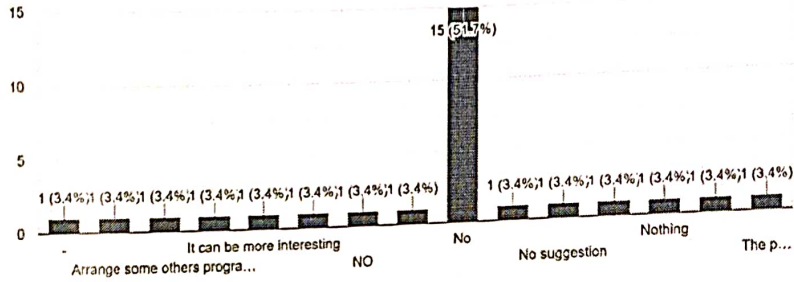
