Objectives:


1. Students will understand the importance of gurus in their lives and education.

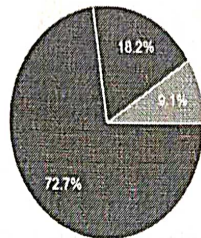

Gurupurnima Day Analysis Academic Year 2023-24



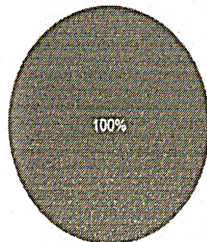
How satisfied were you with the organization and execution of the Gurupurnima assembly?

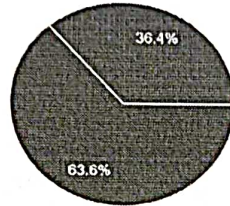

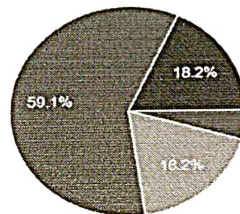
How engaging and enjoyable was the cultural program and activities presented during the assembly?

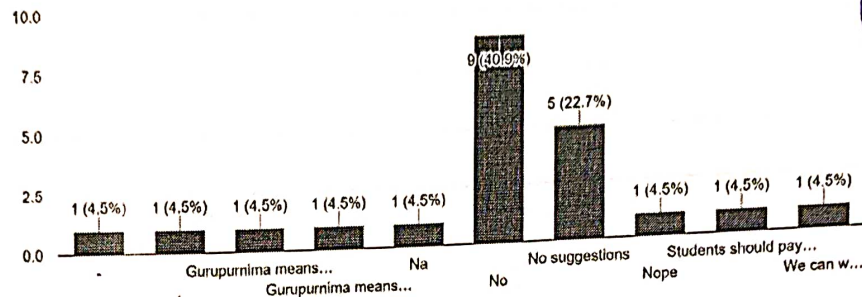
