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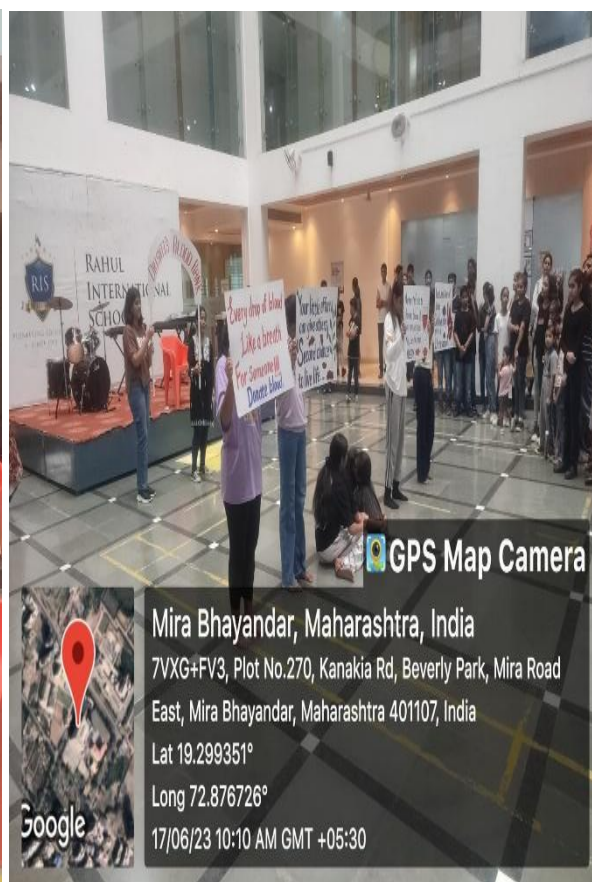
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Blood Donation Campaign:-17th June, 2023

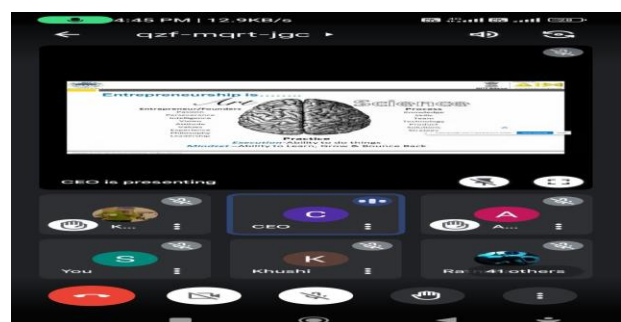
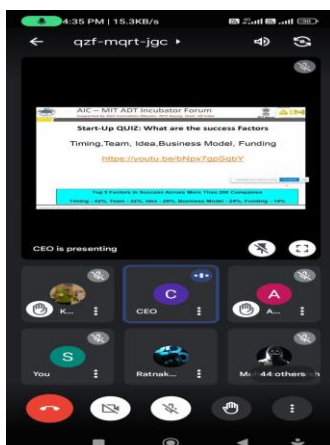
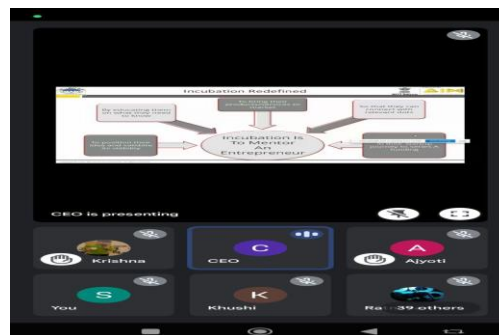
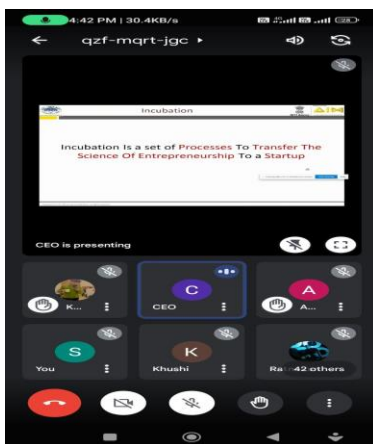
Outcome of the activity:
