
#### 1. Dance Performances:


#### 5. Poetry Recitations:

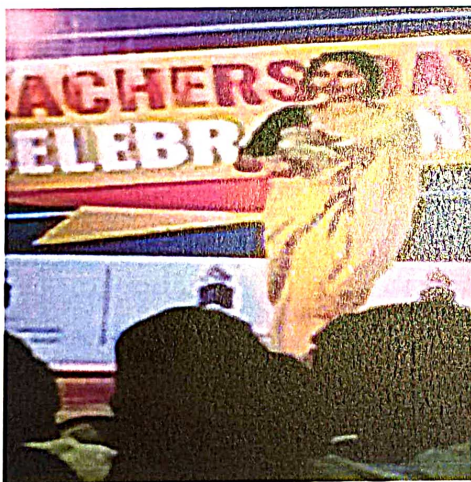
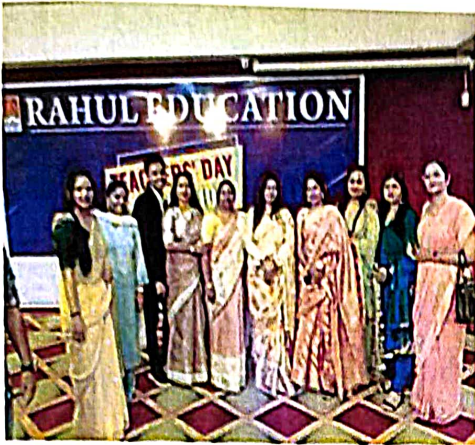
#### Outcomes:

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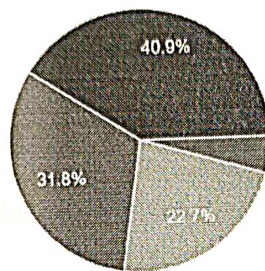
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## Teacher's Day Analysis Academic Year 2023-24



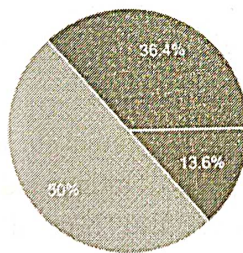
How would you rate your overall experience at the events?

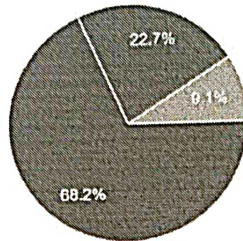




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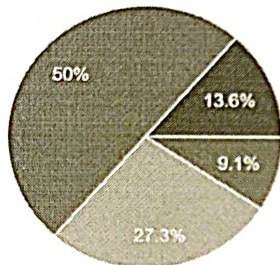
How engaging and enjoyable was the program and activities presented during the event?

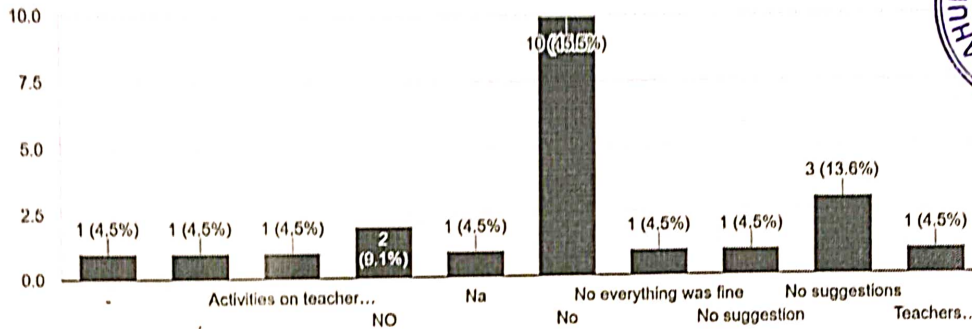


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## Any other suggestions
