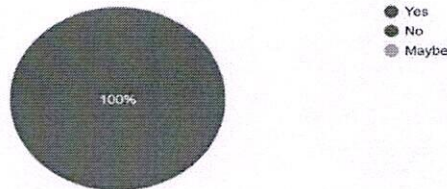
## Christmas 's Day Celebration Analysis Academic Year 2023-24

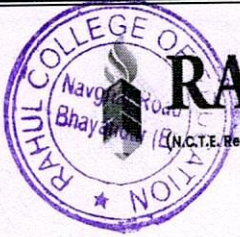

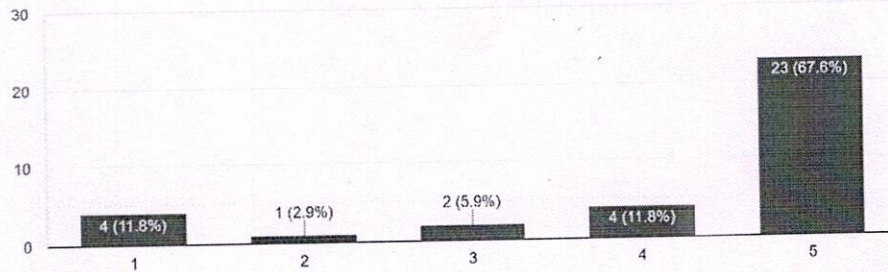

How satisfied were you with the variety of activities and entertainment offered during the celebration?

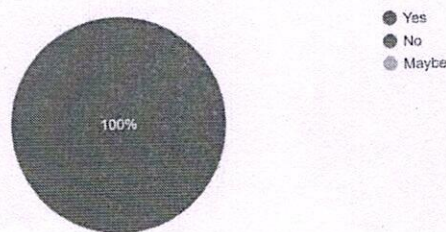

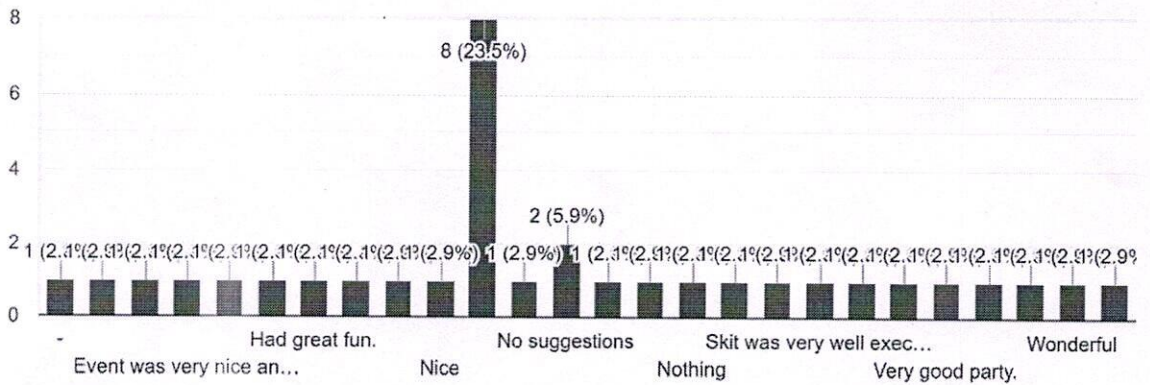
