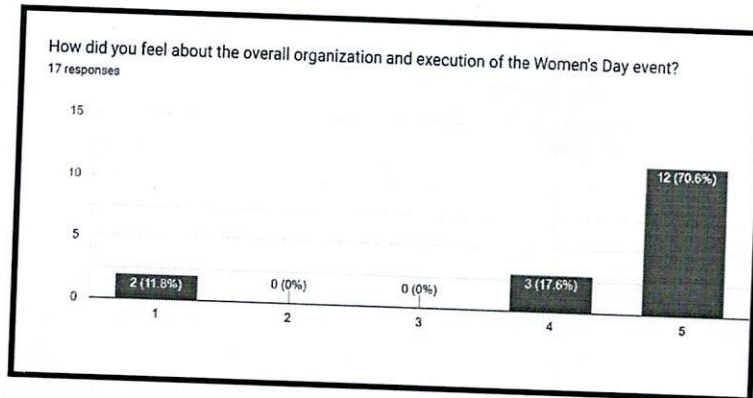

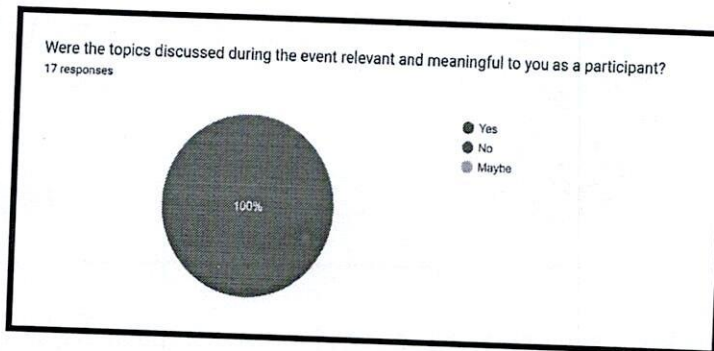
Women's Day Celebration Feedback

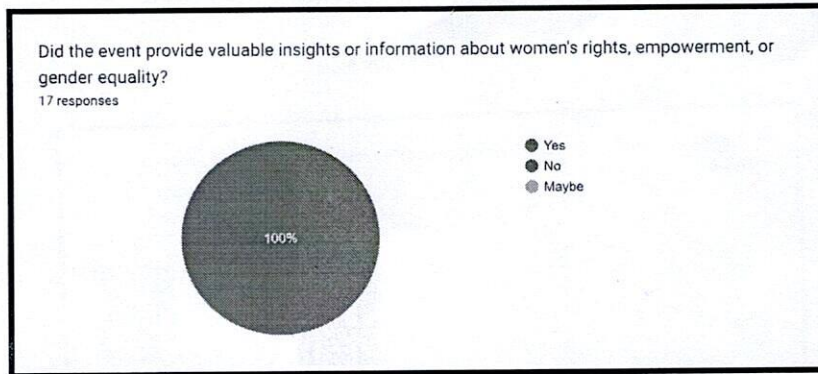

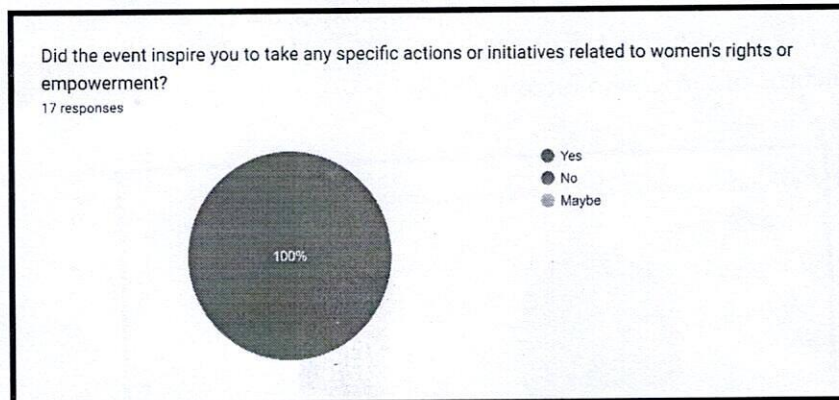

Interpretation :

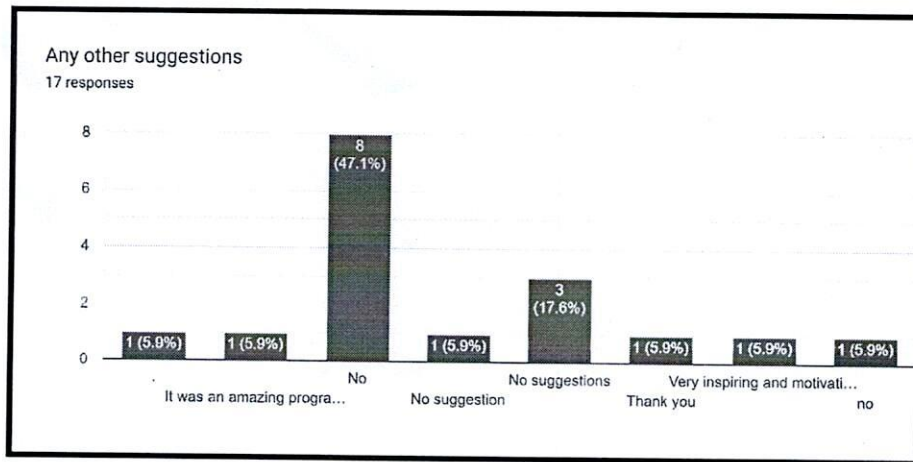
