- This committee assists students in documenting their grievances and resolving issues with resources, academics, and personal grievances in an open and honest manner without fear of retaliation.
- To maintain the college's high standards of dignity by encouraging positive studentteacher relationships and maintaining a conflict-free environment.
- To guarantee a successful resolution of the complaints from students
- To make sure that student complaints are resolved effectively and fairly.
- To assist college students in learning tolerance and mutual respect whenever a quarrel develops.

# SCOPE:

When students file written grievances on any of the following issues, the committee will handle them:

- Academic: Including issues with timely distribution of duplicate mark sheets, conduct certificates, transfer certificates, and other exam-related documents.
- Financial issues: Including fees for hostels, numerous library products, and other dues and payments.
- Other Concerns: Concerning specific issues with hygienic conditions, the standard of food in the hostel, transportation accessibility, instructor abuse, etc.

# FUNCTION:

- On the college campus, Complaint Boxes have been placed so that students who wish to be anonymous can file complaints and offer recommendations for enhancing the college's facilities and operations.
- If there are any grievances of any kind, the person in question can physically approach any member of the Cell, send an email, or write an application and submit it to the Committee Convener.
- As soon as grievances are received, the issues will be quickly handled.
- The committee will examine each case and take official action in accordance with the institutional policies.
- The committee will report to the higher authorities on the cases it has handled and the quantity of cases that are still pending and in need of guidance from them.

# EXCLUSION:


The following matters will not be accepted by the grievance redressal cell:

- Decisions made by the university's executive council, academic council, board of studies, and other academic or administrative groups.
- · Decisions about medals, fee reductions, scholarship awards, etc.
- Decisions taken by the university on misbehaviour and disciplinary issues.
- Decisions made by the university about enrolment in any courses that it offers.
- Decisions made on the evaluation and examination results by a qualified authority.

## Anti-Ragging Cell

#### Introduction to Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC)

The Anti-Ragging Committee serves as the college campus's supervisory and advisory committee in maintaining a culture free from ragging. By implementing a variety of measures, the Anti-Ragging Committee is engaged in creating plans and strategies to reduce the threat of ragging inside the college.

#### **Objectives of ARC**

- Ragging is a humiliating social crime.
- The foremost objectives of ARC are
- To prevent and protect the student community from being ragged or indulging in the act of ragging
- To bring awareness among the students about the ill effects of ragging, its impact on human life and consequences of involvement in the act of ragging
- To receive the complaints and resolve them through the ARC
- To initiate legal actions when required considering the intensity of ragging instances.

#### **Duties of Ragging Grievant**

1. A written complaint detailing the ragging incident in detail, including the date, time, and location of occurrence, must be sent to the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC).

2. The complainant's and the accused's identities should be included in the complaint

- 3. The complaint must be made in person to any member of the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC).
- 4. The Anti-Ragging Committee will protect the complainant's privacy and any other pertinent problems.

#### **Redressal of Ragging Cases**

In case of any ragging case reported

- In the event that a raging incident is reported, the members of the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) shall make quick arrangements to secure the victim or complainant.
- It is necessary to take the victim to counseling.
- The victim and/or complainant must submit a formal complaint detailing the exact specifics of the incident, including the date, time, and location.
- It is necessary to gather information on the complainant and/or victim, including name, semester, section, contact number, email address, parent's name, and parent's contact information.
- The grievance will be entered into the committee members' file.
- The chairperson will be made aware of the complaint.
- To address the matter and determine the course of action, a meeting will be convened in collaboration with the chairman.
- The AntiRagging Cell (ARC) will suggest to the institution's head the appropriate course of action against the accused in the event of a guilty verdict.

#### Actions

- To serve as a deterrence against similar instances happening again, the penalty meted out to those who engage in ragging must be commendable and appropriately severe.
- Depending on the specifics of each ragging occurrence, including its type and severity, the institution's Anti-Ragging Committee will decide whether to penalize or not.
- People found guilty of ragging at the institutional level may face one or more of the following penalties, depending on the specifics of the offense and its severity:(i) Revocation of admission;
  (ii) Prohibition from attending classes; (iii) Prohibition from participating in any examination, test, or other assessment procedure; (iv) Withholding of results

# Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell

With regard to the Supreme Court Judgement and guidelines issued in 1997 to provide for the effective enforcement of the basic human right of gender equality and guarantee against sexual harassment and abuse, more particularly against sexual harassment at work places, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has issued circulars since 1998, to all the universities, advising them to establish a permanent cell and a committee; to develop guidelines to combat sexual harassment, violence against women and ragging at the universities and colleges. Keeping the above guidelines in view St. Joseph's College has constituted a Committee against Sexual Harassment.:

- 1. Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
- 2. Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
- 3. Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
- 4. Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.
- 5. Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.
- 6. Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to human dignity.
- 7. Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offenses, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
- 8. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

# Punishment to those found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments.

- 1. Prohibition from participating in any midterm or final university examinations.
- 2. Temporary suspension from attending classes and the associated academic privileges.
- 3. Revocation of all college-related benefits and entitlements.
- 4. College suspension for a duration of one month.



To make sure that the problems are fixed to everyone's satisfaction, it is critical that they keep the lines of communication open with the instructors and students.

Ms. Janhavi Naik, representing the Admin, stated that discussions with local authorities about traffic control and noise regulation are ongoing.


