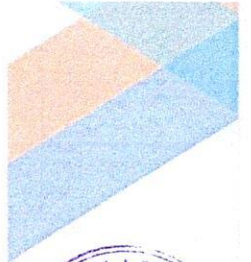
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MINUTES OF MEETING

Minutes of IQAC meeting, held at 11:30 a.m., virtually via Google Meet Plat form on 31st October, 2020

1. The meeting convened promptly at the designated time, with participants joining through the chosen online platform, in acknowledgement of the ongoing COVID-19 restrictions. The Principal, Dr B.S. Panigrahi initiated the proceedings by expressing gratitude for the collectivdedication shown in adapting to the demands of online education.
2. As all are working from home, the format for note-taking, presenting and recording (as access tothe system for developing the MOM was not accessible) the minutes of meetings have been changed – through the consent of the Dr Panigrahi.
3. Mr Yigal Banker read out the previous meeting dated 6th June 2020 (Q1) Minutes before thecommittee.
4. He stressed the significance of this being the second IQAC meeting for the academic year 2020-21 and underscored the importance of maintaining high standards of teacher education, even in virtual settings.
5. He further provided a comprehensive update on the latest directives issued by the University ofMumbai regarding online instruction, examinations, and assessments and encouraged all the faculties to closely adhere to these guidelines.
6. Faculty representatives were asked to share an insightful account of their experiences with online teaching. Overall, all faculties were able to successfully integrate multimedia resources, including interactive simulations, and lauded the use of virtual whiteboards to stimulate studentparticipation.
7. Dr. Panigrahi also recommended organizing periodic webinars to continually equip faculty withthe latest technological tools, an idea widely endorsed by all present.
8. Mr. Yigal Banker proposed a series of targeted workshops focusing on pedagogical approachesspecifically tailored for the virtual learning environment. The faculty members wholeheartedlyembraced this proposal, emphasizing the critical role of adapting teaching methodologies to effectively engage students in the digital realm. He was asked to prepare a plan and with the consent of the Principal implement the same.
9. Mr. Banker further provided an update on the progress of the NAAC accreditation process. Hestressed the paramount importance of meticulous documentation of all online teaching and learning activities.
10. This documentation, he emphasized, would be instrumental in showcasing the college's steadfast commitment to delivering high-quality education, even amidst unprecedented challenges.
