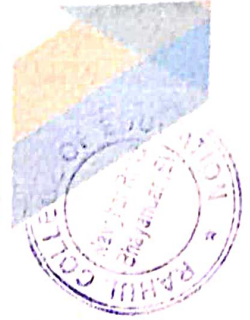

Objective:


