
Report of Feedback Analysis on Gandhi Jayanti and Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti Celebration

1. How satisfied were you with the overall event celebrating Gandhi Jayanti Mira Rosand Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti?



The overall satisfaction for the event varied significantly among participants. While approximately 65% of respondents rated their experience positively (scores of 4 or 5), around 35% provided lower scores (1, 2, or 3), indicating mixed feedback. This suggests that while many enjoyed the event, certain aspects may need improvement to meet broader expectations.

2. How informative did you find the content on Mahatma Gandhi's life and values as well as Lal Bahadur Shastri's leadership and contributions?




The majority of respondents (about 80%) found the content very informative, appreciating its relevance and depth. A smaller group (around 15%) rated the content as somewhat informative, and a very small fraction (5%) remained neutral. This indicates that the content was well-prepared and resonated with most attendees, though there is room to add more engaging or innovative elements for some participants.





3. How informative and relevant was the paper reading on Gandhi and Shastri?



The paper reading session was highly appreciated, with nearly 85% of participants rating it as very informative. Around 10% considered it somewhat informative, while a small group remained neutral. This feedback reflects the session's effectiveness in presenting valuable insights but highlights the need for a broader appeal to fully engage all attendees.

4. Did the paper reading provide new insights or a deeper understanding of their contributions?




An overwhelming majority (approximately 90%) agreed that the paper reading provided new insights and enhanced their understanding of the contributions of Gandhi and Shastri. A few participants expressed uncertainty, suggesting a need for more engaging presentation styles or additional interactive elements to reinforce learning.





5. Participating in the Swachhta Abhiyan helped you understand Gandhi's idea of cleanliness and community service.



Around 70% of participants strongly agreed or agreed that the Swachhta Abhiyan activity helped them understand Gandhi's ideals of cleanliness and community service. However, a notable 30% showed neutrality or disagreement, which indicates that while the activity had a significant impact on many, further emphasis on context and messaging could enhance its effectiveness.

### 6. Did you learn valuable lessons or skills through your involvement in the Swachhta Abhiyan activity?




The activity was well-received, with around 85% of participants confirming they learned valuable lessons or skills. A smaller portion, about 15%, expressed uncertainty. This suggests that the activity was impactful for most, though adding more structured learning components could make the experience more enriching.

### 7. Did the Swachhta Abhiyan inspire you to take action in promoting cleanliness in your community?

The initiative inspired a majority of participants (approximately 90%) to consider promoting cleanliness in their communities. A few participants expressed hesitation, pointing to the need for stronger motivational elements or follow-up plans to encourage sustained action

### 8. Any other suggestions?

The additional feedback highlighted the following points:

- Many participants appreciated the event, describing it as enjoyable, engaging, and well-organized.
- Suggestions included organizing the event in a more formal venue such as a mini auditorium or hall for better ambiance.
- A few participants expressed a desire for better coordination and earlier communication to further enhance the program.
- Some attendees shared inspirational thoughts, such as "Live simply so that others may simply live," which reflects the spirit of the event.

### Conclusion

The celebration of Gandhi Jayanti and Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti was overall a success, with high levels of satisfaction and engagement among attendees. The activities, content, and sessions were well-received, particularly the paper reading and Swachhta Abhiyan. However, mixed feedback on satisfaction and suggestions for venue and coordination improvements highlight areas for refinement. The event successfully met its objectives of promoting values of simplicity, cleanliness, leadership, and community service, leaving participants with valuable takeaways and inspiration.
