### **Description**

Explores gender issues in education, focusing on policies and practices to promote gender equality in schools.

### **Course Objectives**

- Understand the impact of gender as a social construct on education systems.
- Analyze gender-related barriers to education and the role of policies in addressing them.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of existing policies and propose strategies for improvement.
- Develop gender-responsive practices to create inclusive educational environments.

### **Learning Outcomes**

- Demonstrate an understanding of gender issues in education and their implications for policy and practice.
- Assess educational environments for gender sensitivity and identify areas for improvement.
- Design initiatives and interventions to promote gender equality in schools.
- Critically evaluate the impact of policies on gender equality and make evidence-based recommendations.

### **Units and Content Breakdown**

#### **Introduction to Gender and Education (4 hours)**

Instructor: Mr. Yigal Banker

Understanding gender as a social construct. Historical perspectives on gender in education.  
Case Study: Analyze the impact of gender roles on educational opportunities in different cultures.

#### **Gender Inequality in Education (4 hours)**

Instructor: Mr. Yigal Banker

Identifying barriers to gender equality in educational contexts. Case studies of gender inequality globally and locally. Case Study: Evaluate the effects of gender bias in curriculum materials and classroom interactions.



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## **Policy Frameworks and Gender (4 hours)**

Instructor: Adv. Shweta Chaturvedi

Examination of key policies aimed at promoting gender equality, such as:

- Right to Education Act, 2009: Ensuring free and compulsory education for all children with a focus on reducing gender disparity.
- National Policy for Women, 2016: Promoting women's education and empowerment across various sectors.
- Betiyan Padhao, Betiyan Bachao (Save and Educate the Girl Child): Government initiative focused on improving the status of girls through education and awareness.
- Gender Equity Movement in Schools (GEMS): Addressing gender norms and promoting equality in educational settings.

Analysis of policy effectiveness in various educational settings. Case Study: Assess the impact of specific gender-focused policies in local schools.

## **Implementing Gender-Responsive Practices (6 hours)**

Instructor: Adv. Shweta Chaturvedi

Strategies for creating gender-inclusive classrooms, such as:

- Teacher training programs on gender sensitivity.
- Curriculum development that reflects gender diversity.
- Establishing support groups and mentorship programs for female students.

Developing school-wide initiatives to support gender equality, including:

- Anti-bullying campaigns focusing on gender-related issues.
- Workshops and seminars on gender rights and equality.
- Collaboration with NGOs to promote gender education.

Case Study: Design a gender audit tool and conduct an analysis of a school's practices.

## **Practical Component**

### **Gender Audits in Schools (6 hours)**

Conduct gender audits in selected educational institutions. Assess gender sensitivity in policies and environments. Outcome: Ability to identify gender-related issues and recommend improvements.

### **Policy Analysis Project (6 hours)**

Analyze a specific educational policy related to gender. Evaluate its impact and propose recommendations for improvement. Outcome: Ability to critically analyze policies and develop strategies for gender equality.

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Reflect on key learnings from each unit. Discuss the application of gender theories in educational settings. Quality of reflection on case studies and integration of theory and practice.
