

#### **Highlights of the Event:**





- 4. Development of research, analytical, and presentation skills among participants.







The Human Rights Day Celebration- Analysis of Student Feedback AY 2024-25


1. How would you rate your overall experience of the Human Rights Day celebration?

2. Did you find the content and activities of the celebration relevant to the theme of Human Rights Day?








3. How well-organized and smoothly executed was the Human Rights Day celebration?




#### Analysis:

4. How relevant do you think this activity was to your college experience and personal development?






#### Analysis:
