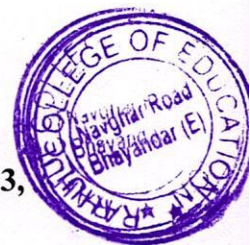



Action Taken Report (ATR) based on the Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on May 3, 2024:

AG01	To read the Minutes of the previous IQAC meeting (16th January, 2024)	The minutes of the previous meeting were read, and no further discussion was required as all members were already aware.

AG03	Integration of Technology	The use of technology in educational processes was appreciated, and more tech-driven initiatives are planned to enhance learning experiences.

AG06	Financial Management and Resource Mobilization	The CTET training program enrolled 21 students, with its success being acknowledged as part of the institution's resource mobilization strategy.
