(Bazerman, C., 1988).

Effective Presentation and Writing Skills Across Disciplines (6 hours)

Instructor: Mrs. Sanjana Mishra Principles of effective writing and presentation skills for diverse audiences. Tailoring communication styles to suit different disciplinary norms and expectations.

Case Study: Create a presentation for an interdisciplinary conference, considering audience diversity (Toulmin, S. E., 2003).

Practical Component

Workshop on Communication Techniques (5 hours) Practice using communication techniques for interdisciplinary collaboration. Engage in role- playing scenarios to enhance communication skills. Outcome: Ability to employ effective communication strategies in diverse settings. Interdisciplinary Project and Presentation (5 hours) Develop and present a project that requires cross-disciplinary collaboration. Focus on effective communication and presentation of findings. Outcome: Ability to communicate complex ideas clearly and effectively across disciplines.

Assessment

Form: Communication plans, presentations, and reflective journals.

Criteria

Reflective Journals (20%)

Reflect on the role of language in facilitating interdisciplinary collaboration. Discuss challenges and successes in communicating across disciplines. Quality of reflection on case studies and integration of theory and practice.

Communication Plans (30%)

Develop comprehensive communication plans for interdisciplinary projects. Application of communication strategies to enhance collaboration and understanding. Quality and feasibility of proposed communication techniques.
