


TEACHERS DAY FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AY- 2024-25

2) Were the decorations and ambiance suitable for the occasion?






celebratory atmosphere but also made the participants feel welcomed and valued. This positive feedback highlights the importance of aesthetic and thematic elements in making events memorable.


