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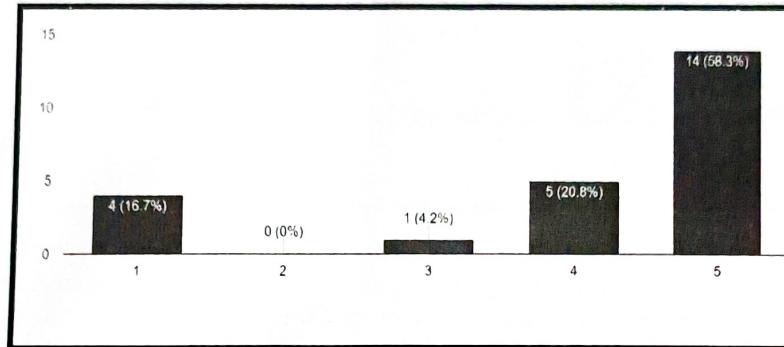

## MARATHI BHASHA DIVAS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

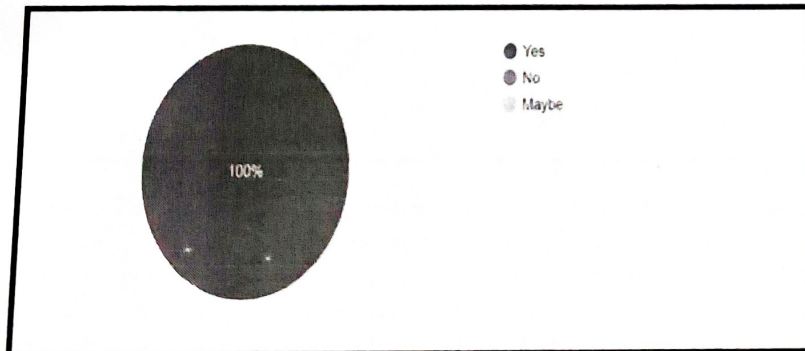

### 1) How would you rate the overall experience of the celebration

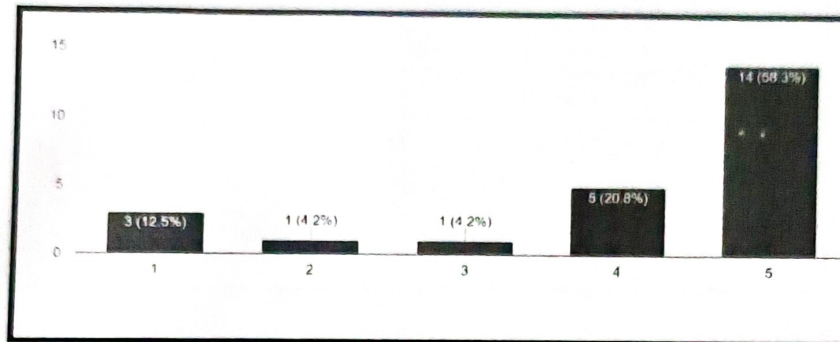


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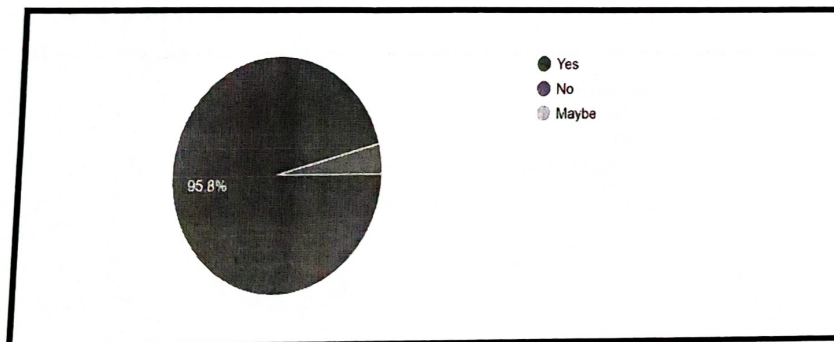


- 3) How satisfied were you with the variety of activities and entertainment offered during the celebration?

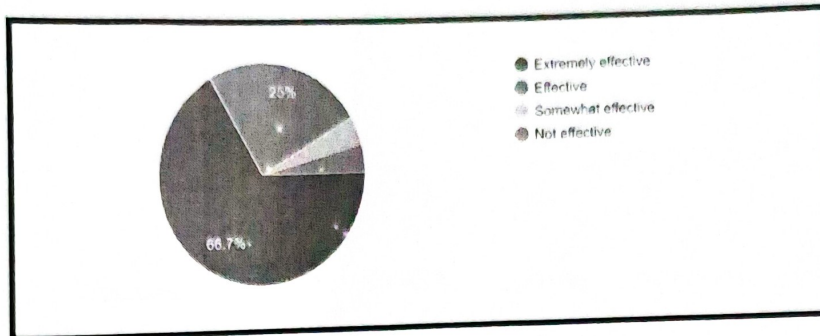


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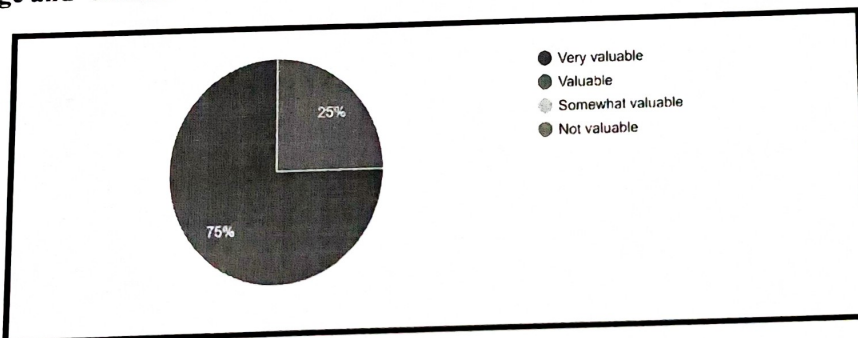


5) How do you feel the event is instilling values related to Marathi language and culture?

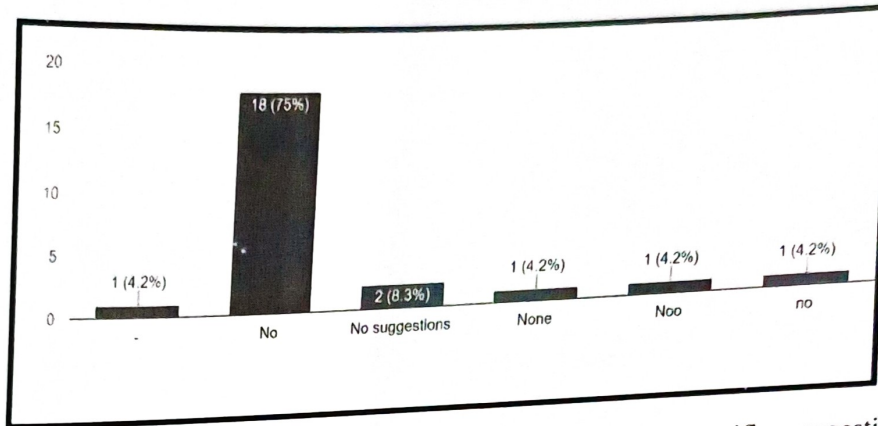




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## 7) Any other suggestions
