Report: Republic Day Celebration Report

Date: 26/01/25

The Republic Day celebration was held with great enthusiasm on 26th January, jointly organized by Rahul College of Education and Shree L.R. Tiwari Degree College of Commerce, Arts and Science, along with the Junior College. The event commenced at 7:50 a.m. on the college premises and was attended by principals, faculty members, and students from all three institutions.

The program began with a warm welcome of the dignitaries by the NSS Leader of the Degree College, followed by the badging ceremony at 7:52 a.m., conducted by the Degree College Students Council. A slow march past by the NSS volunteers took place at 7:55 a.m., displaying discipline and patriotism.

At 8:00 a.m., the flag was unfurled by Principal Dr. Sanjay Mishra of SLRTDC, marking the formal commencement of the Republic Day celebration. The National Anthem was sung at 8:01 a.m. by all attendees, followed by the Dhwaj Geet "Zanda Uncha Rahe Hamara" at 8:02 a.m., and the Maharashtra State Song "Jai Jai Maharashtra Majha" at 8:05 a.m.

The NSS clap by the volunteers at 8:08 a.m. energized the atmosphere, leading into a vibrant cultural segment. A patriotic song was presented by a B.Ed. College student at 8:10 a.m., followed by a Hindi speech by a Degree College student at 8:15 a.m. Another patriotic song was performed at 8:20 a.m. by a Degree College student. At 8:25 a.m., a Junior College student delivered an English speech, followed by a series of patriotic dances — by a B.Ed. College students at 8:30 a.m., Degree College students at 8:35 a.m., and Junior College students at 8:45 a.m. A Marathi speech was also delivered by a Junior College student at 8:40 a.m.

The gathering was then addressed by Principal Dr. Frances Vaidya of Rahul College of Education at 8:50 a.m., who spoke about the importance of the Indian Constitution and the role of educators and youth in upholding democratic values.

The event concluded with a sincere vote of thanks delivered by Mrs. Nivedita Panda, Head of the Science Department, Junior College, at 9:10 a.m., expressing gratitude to all dignitaries, faculty, students, and organizers.

The celebration was a grand success, marked by unity, patriotism, and vibrant cultural expression, reflecting the spirit of the Indian Republic across all participating institutions









Republic Day Celebration 2024-25

Did the Republic Day Celebration foster a sense of community and belonging among participants?






