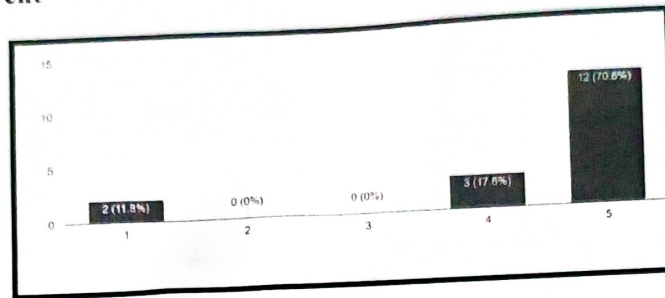

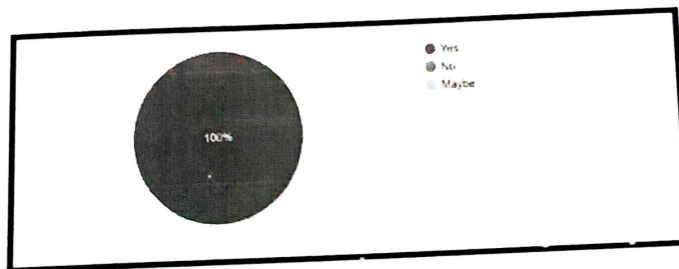
- 1) How did you feel about the overall organization and execution of the women's day event




Interpretation :

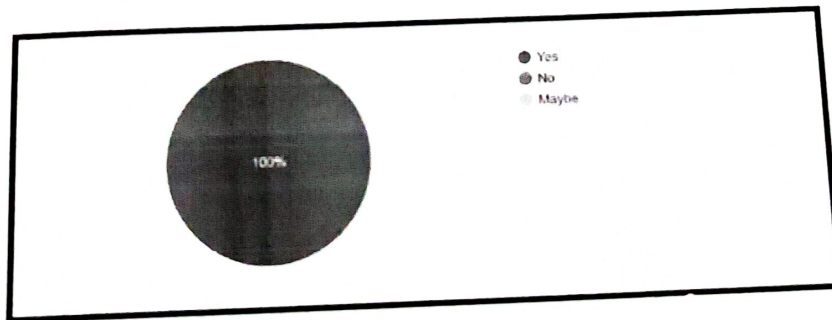
event succeeded in meeting the expectations and needs of its audience in terms of content relevance and meaningfulness.

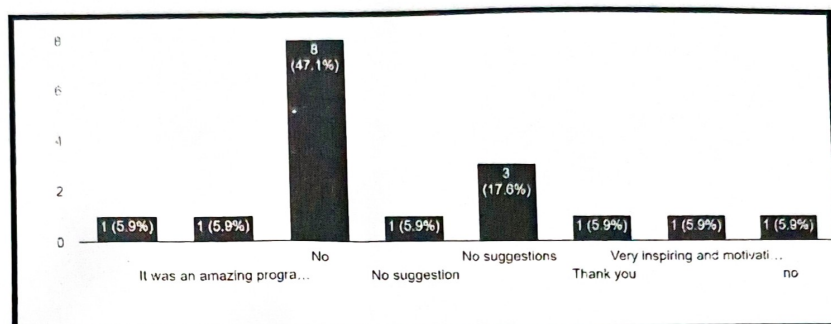
