- The celebration provided a refreshing break from the academic routine, contributing to holistic development.

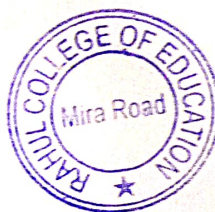
## Conclusion

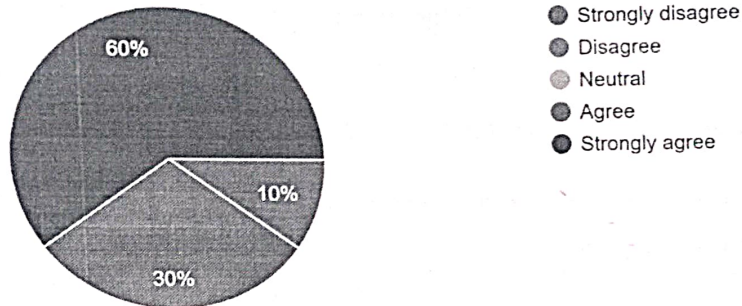

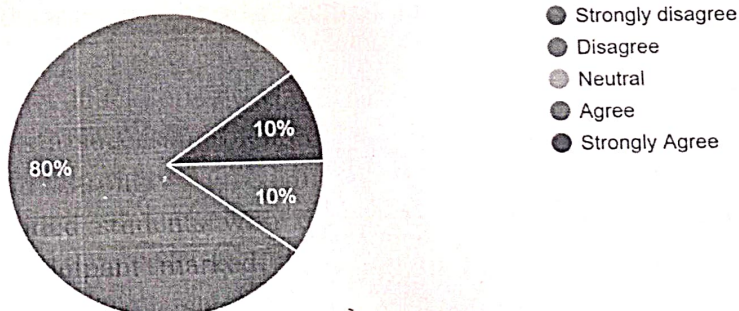
## FEEDBACK REPORT ON GANESH CHATURTHI CELEBRATION

Only one participant marked "Strongly Disagree," suggesting an isolated differing opinion, but this does not overshadow the overwhelmingly positive reception. Overall, the responses affirm that the celebration was impactful, meaningful, and well-received, offering both devotional enrichment and a creative platform for students.

2. Cultural performances brought a vibrant energy to the event and helped build a strong sense of community among students and faculty.





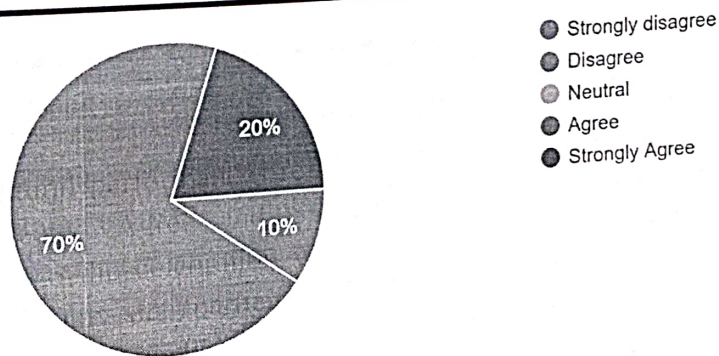

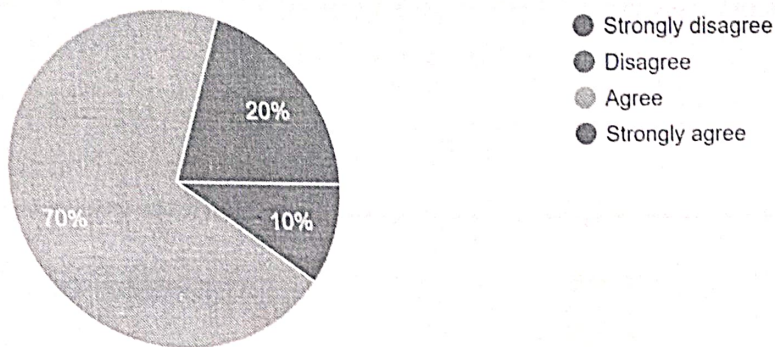




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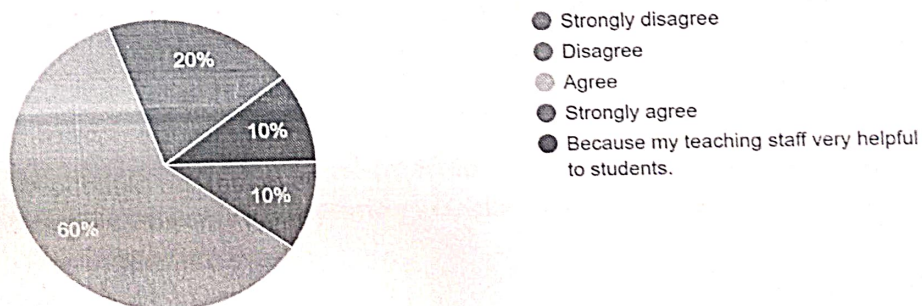
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## 4. The event schedule was smooth and well-managed.

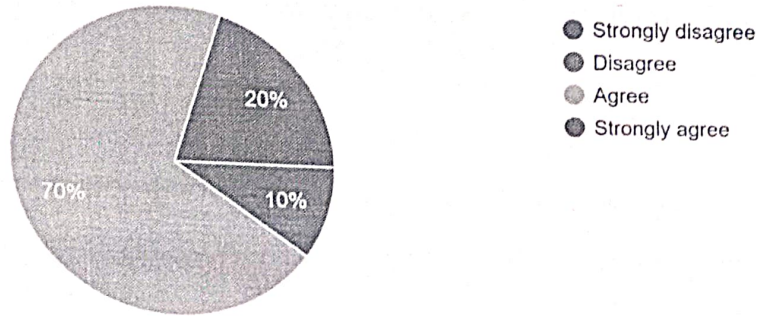




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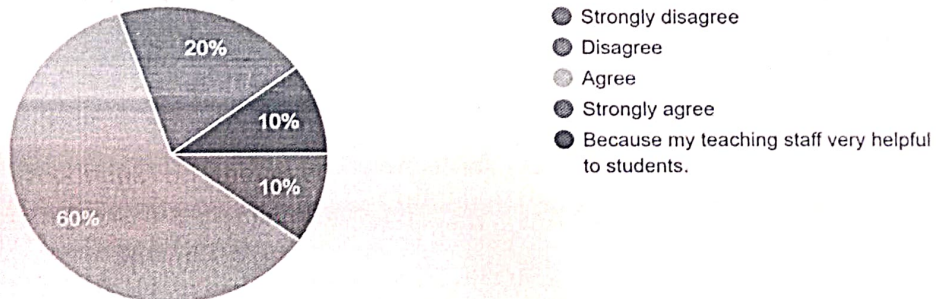
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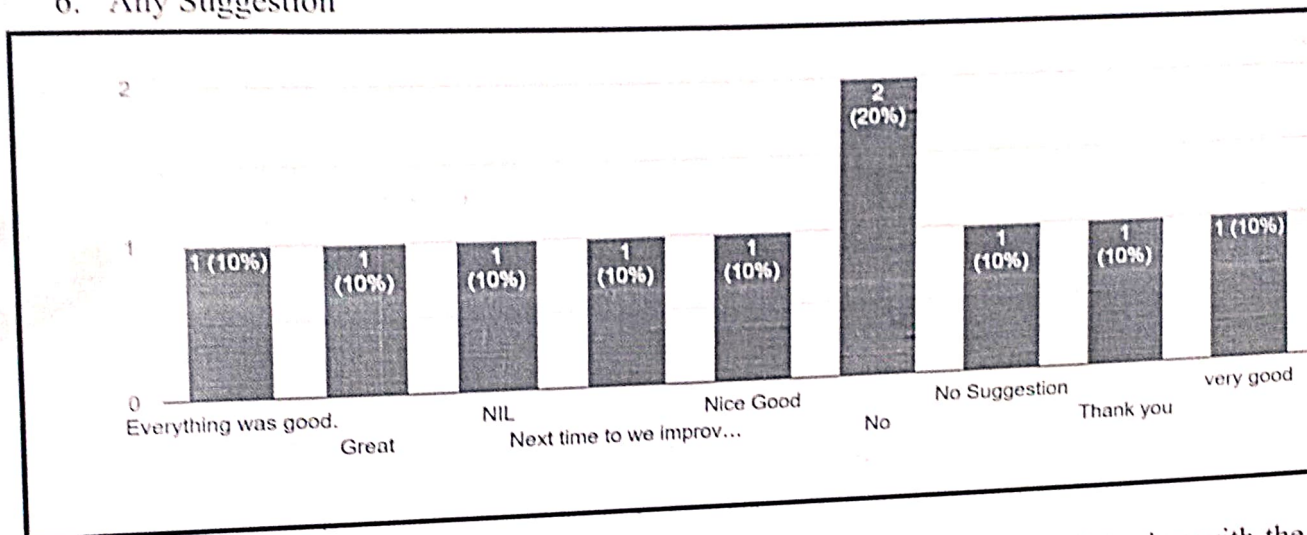
