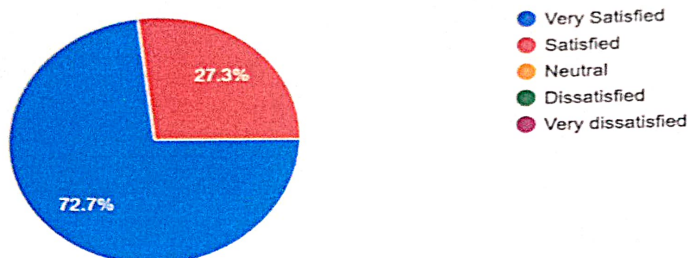

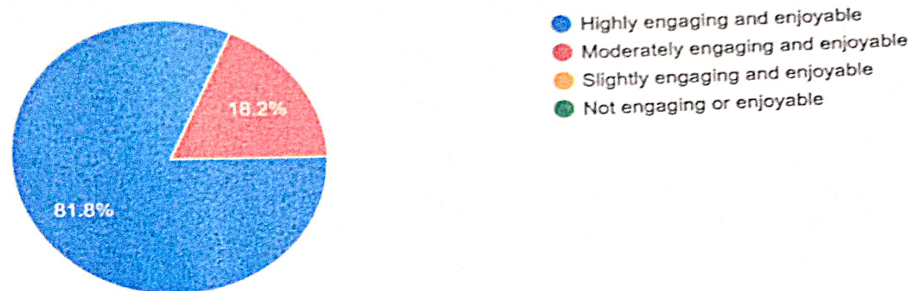
2. Did the assembly effectively convey the significance and importance of Gurupurnima?

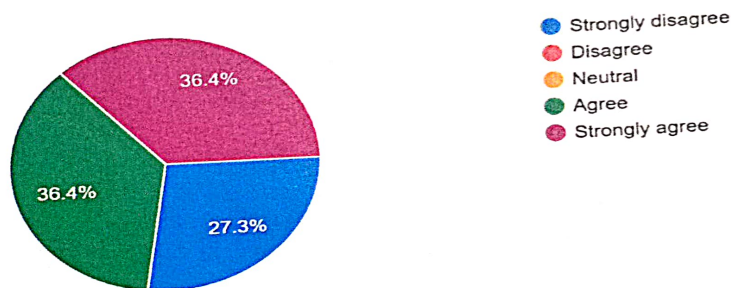


3. How engaging and enjoyable was the cultural program and activities presented during the assembly?

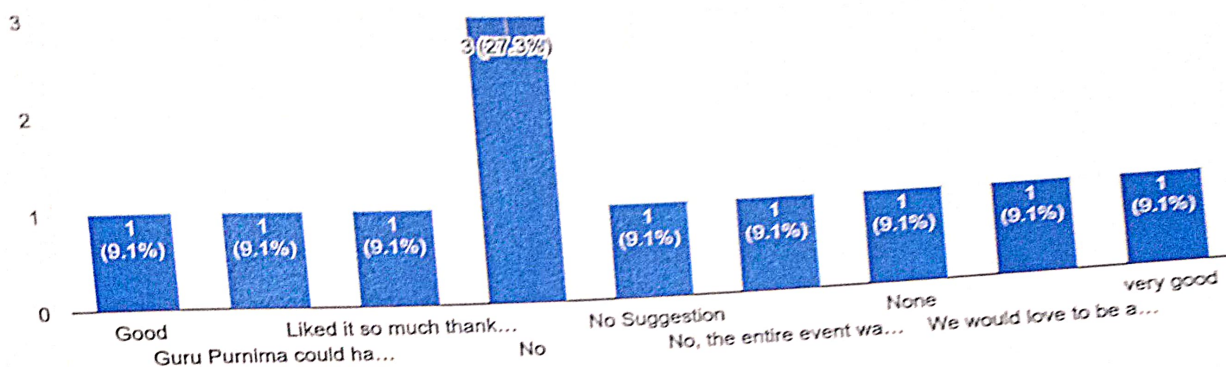




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5. Any other suggestions.
